## **SYNOPSIS**

---

Holiday mayhem is the order of the day in this contemporary South African family comedy.

The Fouchés, an Afrikaans family, arrive at the ATKV Buffelspoort resort for the holidays, only to find that their regular caravan spot has been taken over by the Khumalos. Much hilarity ensues as the two families engage in madcap tit-for-tat exchanges and shenanigans.

Meanwhile, the Buffelspoort manager Oom Gert and his dopey assistant are doing everything they can to prepare the resort for a surprise visit by an inspector from the Tourism Grading Council of South Africa who will determine whether to award the venue an additional star, or not. It's Gert's lifelong dream to achieve the accolade, and this is his last chance before he retires.

Nothing goes according to plan and mayhem ensues. Questions start to arise about the interest in a beauty salon that offers far more than manis and pedis. There's an old lady on holiday with her dog which she struggles to hide as no pets are allowed, a handyman who can't fix a thing, and a couple of local celebrities who think they can get away with not being recognised – all set against the backdrop of the beautiful and peaceful natural environment of the resort.

The tranquillity is most profoundly disturbed by the ongoing clashes between the Fouchés and the Khumalos. Will they be able to set aside their cultural differences and actually enjoy their escape from the rigours of city life?

## BIOGRAPHIES – CAST

---

### **LOUW VENTER – Jan Fouché**

Louw Venter is an actor, writer and comedian best known for playing Corne in the stage show, and later television comedy series, The Most Amazing Show, alongside his creative partner Rob van Vuuren (Twakkie).

Louw and Rob wrote, directed and performed in two TV series and created and performed in more than 200 live shows. They toured all over South Africa, Europe and The Seychelles with the Most Amazing Show and won numerous awards.

In subsequent years Louw concentrated on his writing and film work. He created and featured in the TV series Rugby Motors and was the co-creator and head writer on the TV series Liefste Kayla in which he also featured.

He played the lead in the feature Konfetti, which he also wrote. He was the lead in the features Jimmy in Pienk (Hanneke Schutte), Die Laaste Tango (Deon Meier), Love the One You Love (Jenna Bass) and Alles Wat Mal Is (Darrel James Roodt). In film, he appeared in John Boorman's In My Country with Juliette Binoche, opposite Christopher Lambert in The Piano Player, in Crazy Monkey's Straight Outta Benoni and in Bunny Chow and Rainbow Skellums. He was one of the celebrity contestants on M-Net's Survivor South Africa: Santa Carolina, in 2010. In 2014 he had a starring role as Francois le Roux, in the SABC2 drama series Swartwater.

Louw was nominated for a SAFTA (2013) for best supporting actor in the feature Semi-Soet, and has twice been featured as one of Mail and Guardian's top 200 young South Africans. He also won a Bronze Medal at the New York Festival for copy writing.

### **JUANITA VELTS – Susan Fouché**

Juanita de Villiers is an actress, dancer and performer with a BA (hons) degree in drama. She made her professional debut in 2006, in the Grahamstown festival production Lost in Thought, directed by Christa-Louie van Heerden.

In 2009 she worked under the direction of Shareen Swart in the comical theatre production Hemelbed. Thereafter she appeared on 7de Laan. In 2010, Juanita worked under the direction of Pieter Bosch Botha in the play Noises Off, as well as appearing in Reza de Wet's Mis, directed by Andre Stolz. Later that year she had a role in the film Bakgat 2. She has appeared in short films, stage productions, music videos and TV ads.

In the feature film Koringberg, which was released in 2013, Juanita played the female lead. She also played Dr Marlien Thiart in the soap Binnelanders. In 2014, she appeared in three feature films: Forsaken, Knysna and Somer Son.

She ended 2015 by spearing in Die Pro, the first Afrikaans surf movie. She starred as the young investigator Ella Nasser in the 2016 thriller Die Ontwaking, an adaptation of Chris Karsten's book, Abel se Ontwaking. She also featured in Willie Esterhuizen's Droomdag.

### **JÜRGEN HELLBERG – Arnoldus Venter**

Jürgen started performing at the age of 11 as a member of the world-renowned Drakensberg Boys' Choir in 1972. It was there that he decided to pursue a career in performing arts. He enrolled at the Pretoria Technikon School of Performing Arts, where he met his wife, singer and director Shireen Hollier, and where he was involved in 32 student productions. In 1984 he received his National Diploma in Performing Arts (Drama) and has been working as an actor, writer, singer and producer ever since, appearing in many stage productions and on television.

He has a natural gift for languages and accents, and is fluent in English, German and Afrikaans. He has also acted in isiZulu, Greek and Spanish.

### **EDRIEN ERASMUS – Karen Venter**

Edrien is a versatile singer and actress. Her solo albums include Big Ben and Huisie Innie Stad. Her theatre experience includes shows at festivals like KKNK, Aardklop and Innibos. In 2008 & 2009 she was part of the ensemble for the Add Life Production, Houtkruis – die musical, and Ons Vir Jou. In 2010 she passed Grade 8 Rock school (Trinity) with merit, as well as Grade 8 in 2011, in classical training, also with merit. She formed part of the children's theatre group Boek-Buddies in 2011 and thereafter played the role of Ragel in Ester the Musical.

In 2013 Edrien she played the role of Ouma Elsa, in the musical Liefeling, and in Jesus – die Musiekblyspel she formed part of the ensemble. One of the highlights of Edrien's career was playing the role of the Fairy Godmother in Aspoestertjie – A Pantomime in 2015 at Emperor's Palace. Although most of Edrien's theatre experience has been in Afrikaans, she is bilingual, speaks some German and Tswana, and can do many different accents and character voices.

In 2014 Edrien appeared in the television drama series Aalwyntyd as well as the films Stom and Neem My Saam. Her television experience includes 7de Laan (2010) and Binneland (2012), High Rollers (2013 & 2015), Donkerland (2013), Bloedbroers (2014), Fluiters (2015) and Scandal (2015).

### **MASILO JOSIAS MOLEELE – Ernest Khumalo**

Josias Moleele is a theatre/television writer, actor and director. He began his career in 1993 at Tshwane University of Technology drama department. After receiving his B Tech degree in drama, he became the first black lecturer at the same institution and taught scriptwriting, acting and directing.

In 1997, Josias left the institution to become an educator at Waterkloof Preparatory School. In 1998 he left the classroom to pursue his dreams of being a writer and director. He wrote and directed many theatre productions including Call Us Crazy, which won three Vita Awards. Another accolade was his powerful dance musical Tapsula, which won a Naledi Award.

He presented the wildlife programme 50/50 for SABC 2 called 50/50 and was a referee in Crazy Games, a variety program for the same channel. He played Miles Vilakazi's lawyer on Rhythm City. He has also appeared in numerous commercials, and he had a role in Invictus, directed by Clint Eastwood, as well as the BBC television series Strike Back. He also appeared Leon Schuster's Mr. Bones 2, and Land of Milk and Money.

In 2000, he went into corporate theatre. In 2003, he collaborated with Dr Mark Rittenberg from Berkeley, California to introduce Active Communicating training workshops to corporate South Africa. He then started his consulting company Dos Productions, focusing on training and motivational speaking.

Josias is currently studying towards his Master's degree in drama and has since left TUT Musical Theatre to start his own Arts Academy. He is an author of a motivational book "Doing the Usual in the Unusual way" which is available as an eBook.

### **ZENANDE MFENYANA – Mrs Khumalo**

Zenande had her first audition at primary school, after which he was chosen to appear in two commercials. Today, she is an actress, storyteller, voice over artist, and fashionista. She was also voted by Sowetan readers as one of the top six sexiest female celebrities in South Africa. Her theatre credits include Rapunzel, The Music Show and Madiba Magic. On television, she has appeared in Generations, Ashes 2 Ashes, and Igazi. She has also featured in the films Liefeling and All About Love.

### **JOHAN BOTHA – Oom Gert**

Johan Botha has appeared in numerous television series over his career, from Nommer Asseblief? to Suidooster. Other series he has acted in include Arende, Vyfster, Die Byl, Oupa en Ouma Sit op die Stoep, 7de Laan, Meeulanders and Buurtwag. He has also acted in a number of films including Nommer Asseblief? – Die Rolprent, Circles in a Forest, Die Storie van Klara Viljee, Pad Na Jou hart, and Anderkant Die Stilte.

### **SASHA STROEBEL – Pop**

Sasha has always had a passion for theatre. She studied Musical Theatre at Technikon Pretoria and earned her degree specializing in singing and acting in 2005. Sasha started off her career with children's theatre under the guidance of Gill Gerard and Keith Smith and quickly moved on to PIT Productions (Professional Intelligent Theatre Co). Her first professional production

was *Dis Hoe Dit Was – Die Steve Hofmeyr Storie* in 2007. Since then, she has featured in various productions for Packed House Productions, all directed by Deon Opperman including *Ons Vir Jou Suid-Africa*, *Lied Van My Hart*. She's also worked for Pieter Toerien in the comedy musical *Nunsensations*.

In 2008 she had the opportunity to play a more serious role in the Afrikaans drama *'n Tyd om Lief Te Hê*. She's also done many voice overs and some of the most recent campaigns include *Slender Wonder's* Afrikaans radio adds.

### **KAZ McFADDEN (Karreltjie)**

After matriculating at HTS John Vorster, Kaz enrolled at the Performing Arts Lifestyle Institute (PALI). After completing his third year at PALI in 2006, he made his debut on national television in *Binnelanders*. In 2007 he completed his fourth year at PALI as well as accepting a permanent role on the KykNet soap *Villa Rosa*. Since then he has appeared in other television productions such as *Egoli – Place of gold*, *Die Uwe Pottie Potgieter*, *Koos Roets' Pantjieswinkel* stories as well as *Getroud met Rugby*. He recently played Dewald in *7de Laan* and could also be seen in theatre productions such as *Paulus*, *Noises Off*, *Vaselinetjie* and *Somewhere on the Border*.

Apart from his acting credits Kaz acts as Artistic Director of *Nomad Productions* or the *Nomads* as they are popularly known. As writer and director Kaz has presented *Fladder*, *Grond*, *Skemer* and the Christmas special *Aan die Ander Kant*.

In film, he appeared in *'n Pawpaw vir my Darling*, *Angus Buchan's Ordinary People*, *Katinka Heyns' Die Wonderwerker*, *Knysna* and in *Strikdas*. In 2012 Kaz was nominated for an *Ikussasa Youth actor of the year Award* and in 2015 he received a nomination from the *Royal Soapy Awards*. In 2016, he was nominated for a *Huisgenoot Tempo award for Actor of the Year*.

### **REINE SWART – Bianca**

Reine Swart is known for *Die Pro* (2015) which is the first Afrikaans surf film produced. She had a guest appearance in the international TV Series *Dominion* (2015) as Charlie, the One's mother. Reine portrays the role of waitress Claire in Christopher Smith's *Detour* (2016), alongside Tye Sheridan, Bel Powley and Emory Cohen.

She has portrayed various characters in local television productions such as *Villa Rosa*, *Geraamtes in die Kas*, and *Bloedbroers*, and in the films *Skorokoro* and *Somer Son*.

### **RUAN WESSELS (Dawid)**

Ruan Wessels is an actor known for *Agent 2000: Die Laksman* (2014), *Hoofmeisie* (2011) and *Dis Ek, Anna* (2015). On television, he has played in *Binnelanders*. He has also appeared in



several radio and television commercials. In 2016 he starred at the cricket jock Marco Marais in teen movie *Jou Romeo*, an Afrikaans High School Musical.

### **CHARLIE BOUGUENON – Cedric**

Charlie started his life-long love affair with the performing arts at an early age. Very active in local dramatic societies whilst growing up, he accordingly went on to study a BA Drama at the University of Pretoria where he also attained a certificate in stage combat. Charlie likes getting involved, and has attended many stunt and weapons courses. Most recently, he acquired his Licentiate in Musical Theatre from Trinity College London.

In 2003 Charlie debuted professionally in the national touring production of *Fame – The Musical*. Some of his notable theatre successes include playing the psychotic Dr Frank-N-Furter in a national tour of *The Rocky Horror Show*; portraying the roles of Kenickie, Sonny and Vince Fontaine as a member of the West End international touring company of *Grease*; the diabolical Bombardier Kotze in the critically acclaimed *Somewhere on the Border* at the National Arts Festival, with runs at the Market- and Baxter Theatres; and Mafioso Gyp De Carlo in the national and international touring production of *Jersey Boys*. In 2011 he wrote, produced and performed the one man show *Emphasis on Hopeless* and proudly registered his production company CharlieGuy Productions.

His film experience includes roles in *Revolt*, *Alexia*, *Skorokoro*, Angus Buchan's *Ordinary People*, *The Land of Milk and Money*, *Trouvoete*, *Mossie* and the Afrikaans thriller *Koringberg*. He has also been seen in several Mzansi Magic films.

His television credits include *Homeland 4*, *Strike Back 2*, *Bloed Broers*, *Stêrlopers 1 & 2*, *Getroud met Rugby 5*, *Gauteng Maboneng 2*, *Ses Top'la*, *It's for Life*, *7de Laan*, *Villa Rosa*, *Binnelanders* and *Binnelanders Sub Judice*, *Scandal*, projects for the 46664 Foundation and many commercials.

### **LYALL RAMSDEN – Conrad**

Lyall started his career as an actor in Janice Honeyman's pantomime, *Cinderella*, in 2004. His career highlights include playing the role of Zazu in Disney's *The Lion King* in South Africa and Asia and Riff-Raff in *The Rocky Horror Show* at the New Victory Theatre. He also went onto join productions such as *The Sound of Music* playing the role of Friedrich, *My Fair Lady*, Disney's *Beauty and the Beast*, *Thomas in Ons Vir Jou*, *Tommy* in *Nicky Silvers Pterodactyls* and *Danny Zuko* in *Grease* for Wellington Production House.

His television productions include *Uncle Max* for BBC Film, the role of Mac in *Flesh – A Franz Marx Pilot*, *Hall*, a Tech Officer in *Strike Back* for HBO and John Walsh in *Donkerland* for KykNet (DSTV). He has been involved in several corporate events, radio and television commercials, in all aspects.

### **MARLEE VAN DER MERWE – Genevieve**

After studying entertainment technology at Tshwane University of technology for a year, Marlee completed her three-year diploma in musical theatre at the same institution. During this period Marlee excelled in various areas and having a natural flair for choreography, she was invited to the FNB Dance Umbrella festival in 2004, where her piece Violence on Violins was performed.

After she graduated, she joined the cast of the musical classic Showboat under direction of Janice Honeyman. She has toured the world and has also charmed local audiences in many international musical productions such as Mamma Mia, The Full Monty, Jesus Christ Superstar, Cabaret and High School Musical.

Marlee has also performed as a front-line singer in many supper theatre productions for the Barnyard, Performer Theatre and The Stage Door Theatre. Recently, she played the vicious stepmother, Ursula, in Add-Life's pantomime, Aspoetertjie. Her lifelong dream to work in the television and film industry was finally realized when she made her debut as Melanie in Liefeling. More movies such as Pretville, Pad Na Jou Hart, and Trouvoete soon followed.

She has also enjoyed a busy season on the TV series platform where she played key roles in Sterlopers and Bloedbroers. She made her mark in 2015 in Villa Rosa. Marlee is no stranger to the studio, and music is where she feels most at home. She has been involved in numerous CD productions as song writer, co-producer, arranger and vocal director. She has written and arranged music for movies, albums, and even a fashion parade on 7de-Laan.

### **LINDI STANDER – Hockey Coach**

Lindie Stander is best known for her role as nurse Elsie Kruger in the M-Net soapie Binneland (formerly known as Binnelanders and Binneland Sub Judice). More recently, she has appeared in Villa Rosa. She also teaches drama.

### **MORNE LANE – Writer & Producer**

Morne Lane was part of the camera crew of his first documentary film *Play it as it Lies* in 2006. Today, nine feature films, four television series, five live recordings and many corporate productions later, he and business partner Willie Olwage launched Pretoria-based Cross Kine. The company distributes Christian and faith-based movies produced by Incense Productions, including films such as *Hartsbegeertes*, *Forsaken*, *Rowwe Diamante*, *ReLoad* and *Suiderkruis*.

He has worked with well-known actors and celebrities like Gerhard Steyn, Kurt Darren, Angelique Gerber, Marissa Drummond, Johan Scholtz, Hykie Berg, Gretha Wiid, David Louw, Solomon Cupido and many others. His productions have appeared on Supersport, Kyknet, TBN Africa, ASTV and Kruiskyk TV. He is also a seasoned scriptwriter.

### **MARCUS MULLER - Producer**

Marcus Muller is an actor, voice over artist and director. Marcus is known for his role in *Villa Rosa* as Stef Retief. Marcus Muller's television credits also include *Egoli* in which he played the role of Liam De Lange. In 2006 Marcus was crowned Mr South Africa. Marcus has a great passion for the industry and always goes the extra mile in preparing for a role.

### **LUHANN JANSEN – Director**

Luhann Jansen started out as a camera assistant at 18. Within two years he became a successful cinematographer. After that, he discovered his real love was directed and telling stories. Mentored by renowned director Gerrit Schoonhoven, he directed several television soapies, and became chief director on *Getroud met Rugby*. In 2015, he got his first opportunity to direct a television series – *Kyknet's Sterlopers* – which was a great success. *Sterlopers 2* won a tempo Award for Best Series in 2016. *Kampterrein* is Luhann's first feature film.
